

House Democrats Introduce Bill Package Aimed at Fracking

House Democrats recently unveiled an eight-bill package of legislation targeting hydraulic fracturing techniques used in the exploration and production of natural gas, commonly referred to as "fracking". While hydraulic fracturing is not a new process and has been utilized for decades in oil & gas exploration throughout the United States, more attention has been drawn to the process of late due to new exploration technologies and techniques and a "natural gas boom" occurring throughout the United States. As Michigan has seen a significant uptick in exploration both in Northern Lower Michigan and in communities along the Indiana-Ohio border, environmental groups have voiced concerns over whether appropriate state regulations are in place. The package is aimed primarily at the following objectives:

- Requiring the disclosure of chemicals used in the fracking process and reporting water used when in excess of 100,000 gallons,
- Allowing municipalities and individuals the opportunity to request a public hearing before a permit is issued,
- Allowing local units of government to regulate operations in their communities,
- Creating a public-private advisory committee to study the effects of fracking and suggest recommendations, and
- Increasing the setback distance of fracking operations from residential areas, and applying a setback requirement for schools, hospitals, daycare centers and public parks.

The legislation, suppored by environmental organizations such as the Michigan League of Conservation Voters and Michigan Clean Water Action, is unlikely to see any action in the Republican-controlled House of Representatives. More information on the package is available at www.protectmiwater.com.

Legislature Set to Return in Late August
